

THE GENEVA GEO-CHALLENGE

A NEW TEAM BUILDING EXPERIENCE

Geocaching is a sport that combines GPS technology with the fun and challenge of locating items that have been hidden at various places around Geneva Lake. During the Geneva Geo-Challenge, you and your team will work together to find the information needed to complete the challenge and locate the “cache”. Depending on the reservation, the boat will stop at up to four different places on Geneva Lake.



PREPARING FOR THE CHALLENGE

- All participants should dress appropriately for the conditions. Comfortable shoes and suitable clothing will make the experience more enjoyable.
- The groups will be divided into teams beforehand. The course is set up for no more than four teams at a time.
- If you use your own GPS device, review the basics of its operation. GPS receivers designed for use in cars usually don't work. Spare batteries are a good idea.
- Bring a camera to record the day's events.

GEO-CHALLENGE GOALS

- Challenge all participants to work collaboratively rather than competitively.
- Provide situations where different resources, both human and technology based, are utilized.
- Enjoy beautiful Geneva Lake and exploring the area!



RATES & RESERVATIONS

The Geneva Geo-Challenge is priced as a private charter and therefore private charter rates apply based upon the boat chartered and a reservation is required. There is a small \$100 fee for the additional Crew needed for your challenge.
